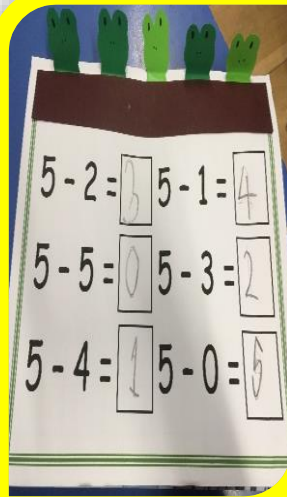
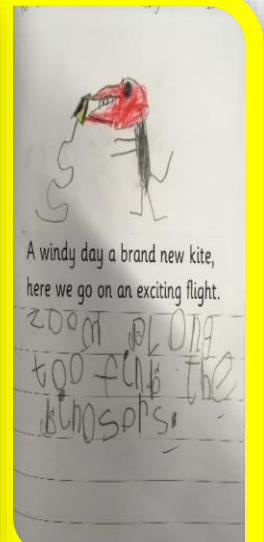


### Reception

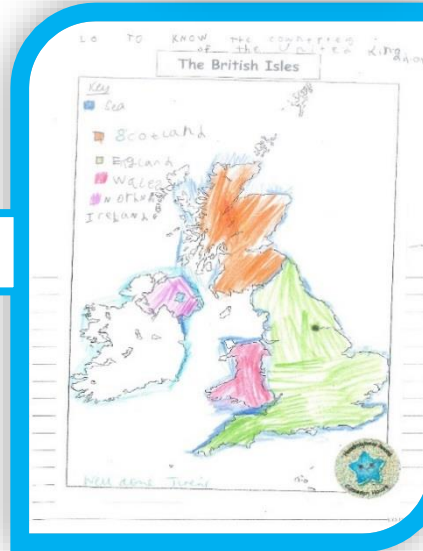
