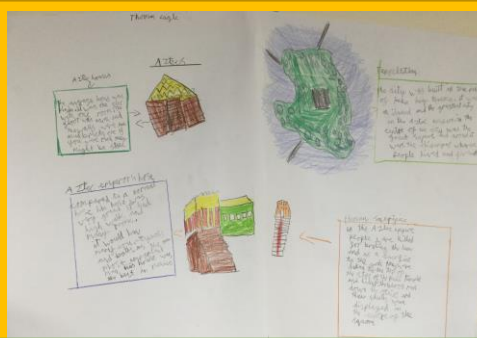

Good Work Newsletter!

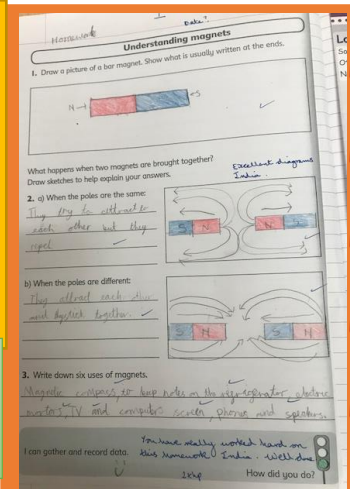

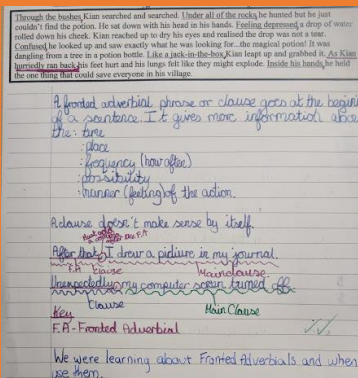

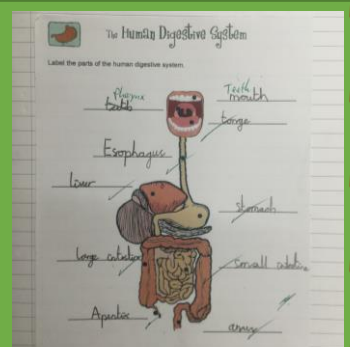
An excellent piece of Science work by India in Class 3! India impressed Claire with her knowledge of how bar magnets work. Fantastic diagrams India!



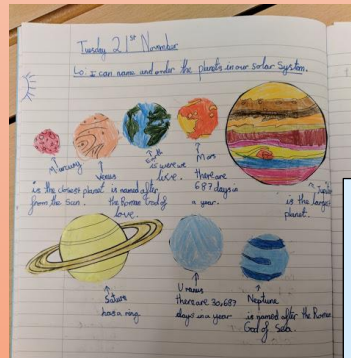
Kathleen impressed Katherine with her beautiful adverbial phrases in Class 5! Well done Kathleen!
